1. **Call to Order:** Drew Bell called the meeting to order at 3:41pm
  - a. All present members signed in.
  - b. Quorum established – Dan Chacon, Thomas Soto, Kirstin Coronado, Ken Stocks, Drew Bell, Cheryl Senn, Chuyita Caldera, Jackie Macias, Karle Campbell, Estela Aguirre, Alisha Sandoval, Kris Boyer, Matthew Canaday
  - c. Motion Mr. Chacon motioned to approve the agenda, 2<sup>nd</sup> motion by Ms. Coronado; Motion was approved unanimously.
2. **Approval of Minutes:** Ms. Senn makes a motion to approve the minutes from the previous SSC meeting and 2<sup>nd</sup> motion made by Mr. Chacon. Motion was approved unanimously.
3. **SSC Training:** Binder review
  - a. Purpose of SSC (page 5) – The SSC body approves the budget after a review of how the money spent and drives the decision making process. Page 13 describes the categorical budget process and the need for the SSC to approve the budget. The SSC is open to public. Meeting was announced in the principal newsletter. Page 39 has a List of acronyms and page 44 has the Robert's Rule of Order.
  - b. Single Plan for Student Achievement – This plan describes how Sanger High will spend their money based on their goals.
4. **Site Plan:**
  - a. Single Plan for Student Achievement
    - i. Goal 1: \$842,420; Goal 2: \$420,918; Goal 3: \$60,000
  - b. Page 3 - Vision, Mission, and SHS goal aligns with the District's goals.

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- i. Page 4 new changes: 14 AP courses 7 honors courses, recognized by US News and World Report, and Newsweek for beating the odds, HS PLC Model school, P21 Organization awarded Sanger High for preparing the students for the skills needed in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.
  - ii. The Needs assessment results of the LCAP survey are located on page 4 and 5.
  - iii. Page 9-11 contains the CAASPP results for English and Math comparing 2014-15 and 2015-16. 11<sup>th</sup> grade teachers are becoming familiar with the new test, technology required, and including 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade teachers in their discussions.
  - iv. Page 13 has CELDT Data (shows students language proficiency) CELDT will sunset this year and will be replaced by the ELPAC.
  - v. Page 15 Title 3 accountability – AMAO 1 Target increasing every year. Didn't make the mark. The Number of EL students are decreasing because the number of RFEPs are increasing. AMAO 2 focuses on LTEL. District is providing training to teachers and admin to focus on LTEL students
  - vi. Page 17 SHS has 3 Goals that determines the decision on how money is spent: Goal 1 – Spend money on helping all students. Goal 2 – Close the achievement Gap. Goal 3 – Safe School Environment
- c. Mr. Soto makes a motion to postpone the vote and move approval of the Site Plan to the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter meeting. 2<sup>nd</sup> motion made by Mrs. Boyer. Motion was approved unanimously.

- a. Question: Is the quorum based on 50% of parents coming or 50% of the committee?

- b. Mr. Soto passed out the Principal Summit, which focused on the same 3 goals as the Single Site Plan. The Summit is shared with the District with more details about how each goal will be carried out.
- c. Question from Ms. Caldera: How can parents become more involved with financial support? Soto explains that Measure A would be a way to support the school financially and continue to come to the SSC meetings.
