

School Site Council Minutes
January 28, 2015

1. President Kirstin Coronado calls the meeting to order at 3:31pm. President Coronado made sure that a quorum was established. Members read the agenda: motion to approve was made by President Coronado, and seconded by Lynette Campos at 3:32.
2. Members were asked to review the minutes from the previous SSC meeting. There were no changes to the minutes; Jaime Lambert moves to approve the minutes, Lynette Campos seconds motion, at the motion passes at 3:33pm.
3. Site Plan: Lynette Campos explains the proposed items to accommodate parent and community member feedback in the Site Plan. She explains that not all funds are accounted for because in March we will find out if our grants are funded. Items of note include expansion of the CTE, ROP, and pathways programs, increases to technology in the classroom, new portable classrooms, increased Summer School, increase counseling services (of all kinds), and alternative education offerings.
4. Budget Proposal from LCAP meeting – At 3:51pm, Budget proposals were distributed to members and reviewed. Afterschool Intervention funds must increase for 20% to meet the raise for teachers. Increase funding to offer CTE offerings. Library renovations, portable classrooms, technology investments, and Summer School extensions were discussed. Mr. Martinez will share information tonight at the LCAP meeting about what the survey showed district wide. Since the money from the LCAP is given to the district, our requests and the results of our survey need to be considered along with a lot of requests from other school sites and other concerns. It will be Mr. Martinez's job to priorities the need across the entire district.
5. At 4:13pm there was some discussion of the psychological services offered now at our school site. Our current services includes group sessions for anger management and drug and alcohol awareness, etc. The next step might be involving parents and family members in some group sessions and inviting them to obtain services if needed. Some mental health forums might also be helpful to get the word out about the resources at the High School. There's one run at Jefferson that is coordinated through the district office. We can request that they run some at Sanger High School. We should put it in the next news letter to parents.
6. At 4:20pm, we discussed the ongoing conversations about the possibility of a Block Schedule for the 2015-2016 academic school year. Ultimately, the possibility seems most likely. Study hall classes and AVID courses were also suggested and discussed.
7. At 4:27pm, Kirstin Coronado gave a WASC Presentation. WASC is the process for becoming accredited as a high school. She discussed the organization of the report, and explained our Schoolwide Action Plan, and it's efforts to infuse technology into instruction to enhance student engagement and rigor schoolwide. She shared the reports' stated goals fro college and career readiness, which go hand-in-hand with LCAP requests and district wide shifts. WASC committee visit is from March 8 – 11, and Sunday March 8th there is a visit where parents may be included.
8. Our next meeting is schedule for March 25th at 3:30pm.
9. At 4:37pm, Kirstin Coronado makes a Motion to adjourn. Jaime Lambert seconds the motion. Motion passes and meeting is adjourned at 4:38pm.
