

School Site Council Minutes  
May 6, 2014

1. Vice Chairperson Cheryl Senn called the meeting to order at 4:02 PM. Vice Chairperson made sure a quorum was established. Members read agenda: motion to approve was made by Dan Chacon, and seconded by Casey Campos. The agenda was approved as read.
2. Members were asked to look over the minutes from the previous meeting. There were no changes to the minutes; Abigail Paxton motioned to approve the agenda, and Dan Chacon seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as read.
3. SSC Training: We reviewed the various assessments used throughout this school year, and discussed the confusion of SHS no longer having an API score due to the waiver Sanger Unified received. CAHSEE results, however, will be the main calculation for our AYP score. Mr. Chacon also explained how the district and school are preparing for the new forms of testing: immediate feedback, creation of the DPAs, school/department created common assessments. He also explained that this time of change for the high school in other ways as well; Paramount has granted SHS enough money to begin a Linked Learning programs with career and technical pathways. This is one of many ways that SHS is attempting to improve graduation rates.
4. Site Plan: Lynette Campos explained the indefinite nature of next year's site plan as the exact numbers have not been finalized. She explained about a two-tiered system to project funding distribution for the following year: base funding of \$150,000 for CTE staffing and any additional funding to be distributed towards technology, professional development, and EL support. Because of the uncertainty of the funding she was sure to say that School Site Council will need to be patient and creative next year. Mallory Lantz motioned to approve the tentative 2014-15 Site Plan projections for Next Year (Including Budgets). Mr. Chacon seconded this item.
5. Public Input: Council was informed about a counselor hired by the district with a Marriage & Family Therapy background. The counselor will help both students and family struggling within the district. They will also hold in-services at various sites and work on a referral-based system. Also, graduation was discussed: practice will be held at Tom Flores Stadium on Thursday and Savemart Center on Friday. Other upcoming events included AP testing and open house.
6. Outgoing SSC members returned binders and were thanked for their service. Returning members included Mallory Lantz, Maria Robles, Cheryl Senn, Bailey Hemma, and Reyna Urbietta.
