

**Sanger High School  
School Site Council Meeting  
5/6/15**

1. **Approval of Minutes:** Kirstin Coronado moved to approve minutes from the last meeting. Ken Stocks motioned to approve the minutes as they were and Mark Pfeiffer seconded the motion. Kirstin Coronado moved to approve agenda. First motion by Mrs. Gens and seconded by Mrs. Sandberg
2. **SSC Training:** Lynette Campos discussed the training of CAHSEE and other assessments and how they use assessment data. Juniors are tested with SBAC in English and math. CELDT testing for EL students test in October and data is used to reclassify or re-designate students. ELLA is another exam that tests language and it is the last year of administering this exam. Another exam is a modified state exam for SPED. Mark Pfeiffer asked when CAHSEE scores come out, which is about the 19<sup>th</sup> of May. The next CAHSEE is May 12-13 for absent sophomores or seniors who did not pass.
3. **Site Plan:** Lynette passed out and discussed the five goals for money allocations for next year's site plan. Based on the money we have for next year, which is still tentative. Goal 1 wording still uses the CST as an indicator. Literacy was added to Goal 1 and students need to reach proficiency on the assessments (money is spent to get students to proficiency levels). Goal 1 has more money allocated than Goal 2 because Goal 1 has more teachers and areas to cover. Goal 2 is mostly math and intervention. Goal 3 demonstrates the need to show growth in scores even if students are not proficient (not as much money is allocated to this goal because we want students to score in proficient). The fifth goal is API improvement. The verbiage is outdated because it is tied to the CST exam that we don't have anymore, but still requires students to show improvement in core areas. Kirstin Coronado asked for motion to approve the site plan for next year. Mark Pfeiffer motioned to approve the site plan as written and Mrs. Sandberg seconded the motion. All present in favor and the motion passed.
4. **Public Input:**
  - a. At the last meeting there were questions about the AP and Paramount programs. Kris Boyer is present to discuss questions about these programs. Kris discussed the summer assignments for AP for current English 9 students. She has discussed with AP teachers about the English and other summer assignments. She said that they are important for background information that students really do need for a solid foundation for the course. Kris brought the assignment with her for the current English 9 student summer assignment and went over all of the requirements for the summer assignment. Sandberg expressed her concern that students take college courses during the year in the Paramount Program, they take summer school, are involved in FFA (showing animals), and are involved in sports, and was concerned with the wording of the assignment. They are also concerned that their students already have a lot on their plate and then they have to add summer assignments on top of it all. The English teachers have made the decision to still assign the summer assignment. Kris can answer questions about the English summer assignment if needed.
  - b. Parent surveys went out in March and 1,710 came back. The top areas for improvement were: 1. Food choices and quality of food 2. Transportation issues, overcrowded buses, and congestion in drop off/pick up area 3. Cleanliness of restrooms
    1. Possibly can have ASB students do taste testing for food service and give feedback to food service to better plan out their meal schedules.
  - c. The top three positive comments were: 1. Teachers willing to help before and after school 2. Safe and caring environment 3. School communication
5. **Collecting of Binders:** Lynette announced that she can store our binders or we can keep them. Invites will be sent out to members for next year's meetings.
6. Motion to adjourn the meeting given by Ken Stocks and seconded by Mrs. Gens. The meeting was adjourned at 4:03 pm.
