Course Overview and Learning Objectives:

This AP French Language and Culture Course is a college-level class which will emphasize the mastery of listening, speaking, reading and writing in French with fluency consistent with the demands of the AP program. Specifically, this course will focus on six cultural themes: 1) Global Challenges, 2) Science and Technology, 3) Contemporary Life, 4) Personal and Public Identities, 5) Families and Communities, and 6) Beauty and Aesthetics. Students will sharpen their French skills in these areas with the precise use of authentic French materials, the exclusive use of French in the classroom, and challenging assignments and projects.

The purpose of the summer assignment is to assure that the students continue to read, write, listen and speak French during “les grandes vacances d’été”.

Summer Assignments: (1000 points)

1. Conjuguemos : (100 points) Conjuguez les verbes français/BEAT THE CLOCK

- a) Go to the site: <http://conjuguemos.com>
- b) 10 times for 10 minutes (minimum)
- c) Record and send your scores to Monsieur Babcock

This site offers you help in the conjugation of verbs/vocabulary/grammar. You need to go on this site a minimum of **10 times** and do **10 minutes** of exercises each time. Press “Record/Submit” and Monsieur Babcock will receive your scores. Please concentrate on the following tenses: Présent, Imparfait, Passé composé, Futur, Conditionnel, Subjonctif, Impératif !! Challenge yourself ! Focus on the irregular verbs. After having submitted « 10 times », you will get Extra credit for any EXTRA work you do on this site ... just remember to press “submit (record)/send.”

2. L'écoute et la Lecture (Listening and Reading) (600 points)

In order to increase listening and reading proficiency (including vocabulary growth), plan to spend at least 20 minutes per day (three days per week for six weeks) viewing the assigned videos and reading the transcriptions (see video clip page). Listening to the clip over and over will allow you to understand French better and better.

From these listening and reading resources, in a journal, write down the names of the videos you studied and at least **5 new French vocabulary words for each video clip**. You should have a list of **15 words per week**. Then include a short, two or three sentence summary of the video clip **in French**. Place each week's vocabulary list and summary on a page with a heading of the **title and the date completed**. By the time school begins, you should have at least **6 lists of 15 vocabulary words = 90 new words!!!** Study these!! Learn them!! Be ready for an accountability quiz when school begins. In addition, if you put these words or phrases on flashcards, the French word or phrase on one side and the English definition on the other, I will give extra credit. Be prepared to show me the flashcards you created when school starts.

3. Google Voice (200 Points)

Call me twice during the summer, once at the **end of June** and the other at the **end of July**, at the following Google Voice number: 559-492-6578. Leave a message (in French, of course) after the beep in which you tell me 1) your first and last names and 2) what you have done that month for fun, for work, etc. ... books you have read, movies you have seen, trips you have taken, etc. Your message should be at least one minute long, more is better.

4. 2-Minute Presentation (100 Points)

Be prepared to share the same two minute presentation about one of the AP themes that you prepared for the French 3 Spring exam (100 points).

- 1) Login
- 2) Go to Library, then tap French Verbs, and choose the tense you want to work on
- 3) Click the Graded Practice Mode
- 4) Set the timer for the desired duration
- 5) Press Start
- 6) Type the correct form of the indicated verb and press Enter ... then continue
- 7) When time runs out, click on Record Score
- 8) To start over, or to do it again, click on the button Activity Page and repeat these directions
- 9) Note that on the right side, there is a button to customize your settings and choices.
